### Stevensons is the uniform stockist for St Joseph's College uniform.

Items can be pre-ordered online directly through the [Stevensons website](#) or you can visit their central Reading store in Chatham Place RG1 7AZ. There is a multi-storey car park in the near vicinity. Items can be collected in branch or delivered to your home address. Their free tracked return process can be completed via their website and, if you wish, items collected directly from your home.

## UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT FOR LEARNING CONT.

### PREP SCHOOL UNIFORM & EQUIPMENT LIST

**Pupils should keep their uniform clean and neat.**

**All items should be clearly marked with their name.**

- Correct College uniform should be worn at all times
- Shoes should be black, a school-type style and polished regularly. No trainers
- Blazers should be worn at all times
- Shirt top buttons must always be done up and ties full length
- Swimming hats are provided by the College and the cost added to your invoice

#### **BAGS**

- It is important that pupils do not carry unnecessary books in their bags
- Bags are part of the uniform and must not be decorated or defaced

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- Hair must be smart, professional in style, and worn off the face. Exaggerated or dyed/coloured hair styles are not permitted - hair should not be excessively long or short and hair accessories must be simple and a natural hair colour
- No jewellery is allowed except for a wristwatch and/or one small crucifix or recognised symbol of faith worn discreetly around the neck/wrist
- One gold or silver stud may be worn in the lobe of each ear. Pupils must be able to remove them independently for all sport and swimming lessons
- No nail polish or make-up is to be worn in school

Items can be ordered online or bought in the Stevensons Reading store. **Non-branded items on the uniform list can be purchased from Stevensons or any other reputable supplier.**
